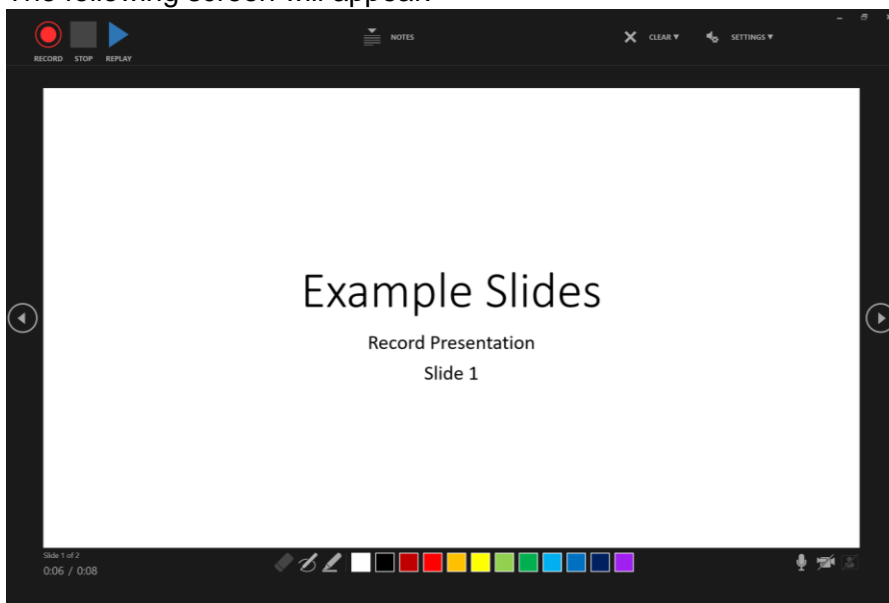
Pre-recording presentations – A quick start “how-to” guide

Option 1: Presentation Recording using PowerPoint

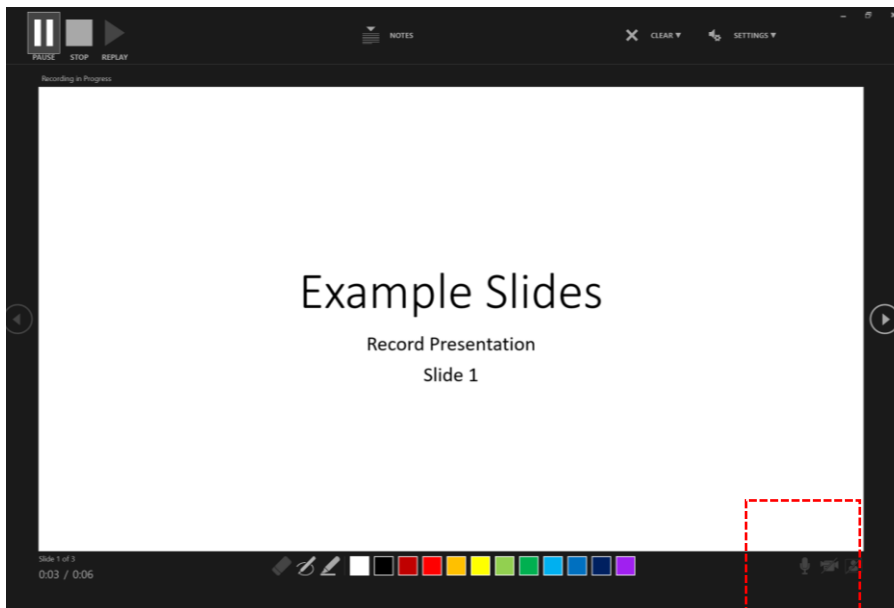
1. Create a separate copy of your slides



2. Under the Slide Show task bar, Click , then select “record from beginning” from the dropdown list.
3. The following screen will appear:



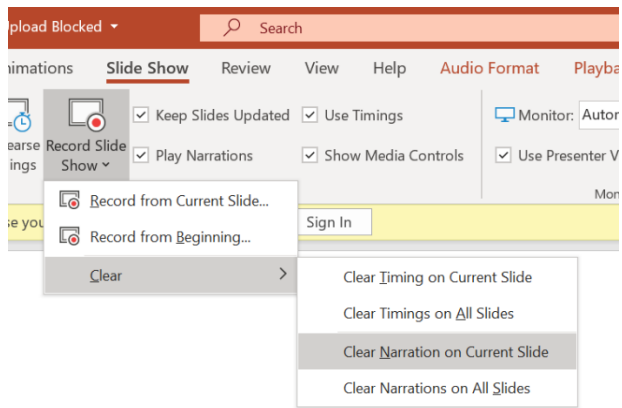
4. Click the “RECORD” button (top left corner), and after 3 seconds counting down, the presentation will start recording. The screen during recording appears as follows.



5. The “Microphone” (bottom right corner) needs to be turned on all the time. You are also encouraged to turn on the “Camera” during the presentation.
6. Click “Stop” button (top left corner) to stop recording.
7. A speaker icon will appear at the bottom right corner of each slide as follows. You can press “F5” to replay the whole presentation. Each individual slide can be replayed by clicking the speaker icon.



8. You can remove the recording of individual slides OR all the whole recording using the “clear” function shown as follows If you are not happy with the recording.



9. Once you are happy with your recording, please send the Power Point file (the one with the speaker icon!) to the ISGSR 2022 Organising Committee.
